Zero — The number 0 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying sŏon. In the space below draw the symbol for zero five times.

One — The number 1 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying nèung. In the space below draw the symbol for one five times.

Two — The number 2 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying sŏrng. In the space below draw the symbol for two five times.


Three — The number 3 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying sǎhm. In the space below draw the symbol for three five times.


Four — The number 4 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying sĕe. In the space below draw the symbol for four five times.


Five — The number 5 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying hâh. In the space below draw the symbol for five five times.


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Six — The number 6 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying hòk. In the space below draw the symbol for six five times.

Seven — The number 7 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying jèt. In the space below draw the symbol for seven five times.

Eight — The number 8 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying bpàirt. In the space below draw the symbol for eight five times.

Nine — The number 9 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying gâo. In the space below draw the symbol for nine five times.

Ten — The number 10 is written by drawing a  It is pronounced by saying sìp . In the space below draw the symbol for ten five times.
